If you are an undergraduate student in your second year of the Bachelor of Engineering in Civil, Electrical or Mechanical Specialisations, you may be eligible to apply for the Xstrata Coal Undergraduate Scholarships in Engineering valued at \$10,000.

To be considered for the scholarship applicants must: Be enrolled full time

Be enrolled in your second year of the Bachelor of Engineering (Civil, Electrical or Mechanical specialisations) Be an Australian Citizen or permanent resident Not hold any other scholarships

Complete and submit the relevant scholarship application form and include a CV stating career and other community involvement to date, a written letter of application outlining aptitude, level of interest in working in Engineering, personal qualities, leadership qualities and extracurricular activities.

The scholarship is tenable for up to 4 years for a Bachelor of Engineering (Civil, Mechanical or Electrical specialisations) program. The scholarship is subject to semester review. Continuation of the scholarship is subject to the scholar achieving a credit average or better for each semester.

Students will be required to attend an interview with the selection committee. This committee will comprise the Head of School of Engineering (or agreed delegate), the Head of Electrical Engineering (or agreed delegate) & 1 representative of Xstrata Coal.
