- be enrolled in the second year of the Bachelor of Engineering (Civil, Electrical or Mechanical specialisations);
- be enrolled full-time
- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident;
- not hold any other scholarship;
- Complete and submit the relevant scholarship application form and include a CV stating career and other community involvement to date, a written letter of application outlining aptitude, level of interest in working in Engineering, personal qualities, leadership qualities, extracurricular activities and community involvement.

SELECTION

- The Scholarship shall be awarded by the Dean of the Faculty based on the recommendation of:
- Head of School of Engineering (or other agreed delegate)
- Head of School of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science (or other agreed delegate)
- One (1) representative of Xstrata Coal
- The scholarship shall be awarded on academic merit, leadership potential, personal qualities and community involvement.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- The scholarship is tenable for up to four (4) years for a Bachelor of Engineering (Civil, Mechanical or Electrical specialisation) program. This tenure may be extended as authorised by the donor for approved combined degree scholars.
- The scholarship must be taken up in the year for which it was awarded.
- The scholar shall continue to fulfil the relevant eligibility criteria specified above, for the duration of the scholarship.
- The scholarship is subject to semester review. Continuation of the scholarship and benefits are subject to the scholar maintaining satisfactory academic progress, that is, attaining a credit average or better for each semester. The scholarship holder agrees to release a copy of each semester's university results to the donor.
- This scholarship is subject to the availability of funding from the donor.
- The scholar shall not be required by the donor [or the University] to undertake employment as a condition of award of the scholarship.

BENEFIT

- Scholarships may be offered annually. The scholarship provides a total of \$10,000 per annum for commencing students and \$10,000 per annum for continuing students. The scholarship is payable in a \$5000 lump sum payment each semester after the census date for commencing students, and as a \$5000 lump sum payment each semester after the census date for continuing students.
- Xstrata Coal may offer the recipient paid industry vacation employment for three months for commencing and continuing students from December to February.

SUSPENSION OF SCHOLARSHIP BENEFIT

- A scholar may apply in writing for a suspension of the scholarship benefit because of illness, injury or other extenuating circumstances. An application must be supported by appropriate documentary evidence. Periods of approved suspension shall not reduce the tenure of the scholarship.

TERMINATION

APPEALS
